FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

Last year I spent the bulk of Pentecost covering the articles of the Augsburg Confession. I was shocked at the overwhelming positive responses that were offered throughout the course of those summer and fall months. Given the reaction and the feedback from so many of you regarding what was being learned, in addition to a newfound motivation to come to church regularly to keep up with this topic that continued to build upon the prior weeks, it seemed fairly obvious it would be beneficial to begin another series. Having a connected subject not only creates an additional reason to keep up with attending over the summer months but also grants an opportunity to tap into often ignored content when utilizing the standard lectionary readings.

Starting June 15th, we will begin the book of Genesis and a chapter a week will replace the lectionary Old Testament and Psalm readings. We will still use the New Testament and Gospel as normal, but as a congregation we will collectively hear and discuss the entire book from beginning to end. Anytime a Sunday is missed, I strongly encourage you to read the chapter that was covered on that Sunday to keep up with the progression of the story. Given the connectivity throughout the books of scripture and number of cross references that occur, nearly 65,000, there is a ceiling to the potential of comprehension that forms if what takes place prior is not properly understood. The plan is to take our time, start at the beginning and I truly believe this will open many doors of newfound understanding that otherwise would have remained closed.
